Client

Basic – Provides fewer features than the premium client but offers faster performance. If on a slow connection, you should select Basic.

Security

Public or shared computer – Choose this option if you use OWA on a public computer (i.e. airport kiosk). This option will not allow you to open attachments.

Private computer – Choose this option if you are the only person who uses the computer. Your Exchange server will allow a longer period of inactivity before logging you off.
